

Warwick Schiller Attuned Horsemanship - Clinic Participant Information

Clinic Check In:

Normally participants will be arriving the day before a clinic starts. You will be advised of arrival and departure information prior to the clinic.

Depending on location and who is assisting at the clinic, you will "check in" either on the day you arrive or the morning of the first day of the clinic. Ensure that you bring your signed release form with you and if there is anything else due, please have that in hand.

1:00 PM Group 2 ends, Group 3 begins

2:30 PM Group 4 come in with horses

3:00 PM Group 3 ends, Group 4 begins

Day 3:

7:30 AM Group 1 come in with horses

8:00 AM Group 1 begins

9:30 AM Group 2 come in with horses

10:00 AM Group 1 ends, Group 2 begins

11:30 AM Group 3 come in with horses

12:00 PM Group 2 ends, Group 3 begins

1:30 PM Group 4 come in with horses

2:00 PM Group 3 ends, Group 4 begins

If it's a 2 day clinic only, the day 2 schedule is day 1 and day 3 is day 2.

These times are approximate - Warwick will not just leave someone hanging if they are in the middle of something.

Lunch is not guaranteed, eat when you are hungry.

Clinics are to give hands on assistance to people with their horses as they follow Warwick's process. It is normal to need additional help with places you might feel stuck or where you want to progress to the next step in the process. Warwick will identify areas that need work, i.e. if the basics are not solid, you will be working on basics!

It is very important that you are immersed in the video library prior to the clinic. We will send you emails in the lead up to the clinic to help you best prepare. Getting the basics solid before the clinic will ensure that clinic time can be spent building upon those principles and tools instead of working on only them at the clinic.

Most clinics are now 3 day clinics. The first day is spent without spectators in attendance. We have found that this day with participants only builds a great bond between participants and then when clinic day comes around, they feel like they have additional support. This day also gives Warwick time to figure out where everyone is in the process, what they want to work on and get a lot of preparation work completed. It has been a great addition.

Unlike other clinics you may have attended, Warwick works with you and your horse where you are. You won't necessarily be doing the same thing as the person next to you. **You will not move on past any step that needs work.** So, if you want to solve a problem and you don't have the tools to do so, you will work on the tools. If you want to work on something technical and the steps leading up to that are not good enough (or your horse is not relaxed in the clinic environment), you will work on the remedial steps and you may not get to the technical part. This is how Warwick is successful with horses, because he makes sure the basics work really really well. Once they do, everything else is easy!

To get the most value from your clinic experience, it's important to honestly assess both your own abilities and your horse's. Clinics provide an opportunity for Warwick to observe you and your horse in action, offering personalized feedback to help you improve. Coming with an open mind, a sense of humor, and a willingness to receive and apply feedback will ensure you make the most of the experience and see meaningful progress with your horse.

Warwick's goal is to create a positive and educational environment for all participants. His teaching style includes analogies, stories, immediate corrections, and group learning moments, all designed to enhance your understanding and skills. If you prefer a different style of instruction, you may find some aspects of the clinic challenging. Participation is always your choice, and we encourage an open mind, a willingness to learn, and a passion for improving your horsemanship.
